Ventana Community Concerns:

NEW TRASH SERVICE PROVIDER:

• Please be aware that you will be receiving new trash and recycle bins with a new provider this month. Look out for the letter with details regarding this transition – you can also find a copy of this letter on the website.

Parking on Public Streets:

• Although the streets are public owned and maintained by City of Fountain, please be courteous when parking alongside neighboring properties. Be sure to not block your neighbors access to their property, sidewalks, or abandon your vehicles along their property line.

Recreation Center/ Pool News Update:

Pools is Opened: (Hours of operation are 8:00 am – 10:00 pm)

Do not open the gate/ door to let others in the pool area or building

- If someone's key fob is not working, there is a reason for that, and the Rec Center Staff can help them while they are there. Otherwise, you will be liable and responsible for any damage, disruption, or fees for the guest let in.
- Each household must have their own key fob to access the area.

Hot Tub/ Spa Alert:

• For safety children smaller than 115 lbs. are <u>NOT</u> allowed in the Hot Tub/ Spa. A person who weighs 115 lbs. in a Hot Tub at 104 degrees, their core body temperate can get to 102 degrees in less then 15 minutes.

Guest Use at Rec Center:

• You are allowed to bring (at \$5/ guest) 4 guests to the Rec Center per household. Any more guests past 4 is considered a party and you will need to reserve the Great Room area and pay \$200/ refundable security deposit plus the cost of guests. Follow the below guidelines for Renting out the Great Room area.

Renting for Parties:

• Great Room Renting: If you are interested in renting the Great Room area for a party you can fill out an application online (https://form.jotform.com/211314853718051). Please note that rentals are not allowed on Holidays, and you will need to apply at minimum a week ahead of time. If you have questions, please call.

Ventana Community Covenant Reminders:

Summer is here! As the summer heat continues in Ventana, we want to send a friendly reminder to make sure your neighborhood is as welcoming as the weather.

We provide a regular inspection community service to ensure covenant compliance. As you are busy getting your own houses and yards in shape, we want to remind you of some of the covenants that are intended to ensure the quality, value, desirability, and attractiveness of all property within the Community.

- Please be sure to keep your lawns in an orderly fashion by not allowing an excessive amount of grass to die off, weeds to grow, and keep the lawn at a reasonable mowed height. <u>If your yard/ lawn/ grounds have any of these</u> concerns you will receive 2 warnings/ violations for the same concern.
 - Section 4.01 Building and Grounds Maintenance.
 - o Section 4.08 Weeds.
- Please note that if your pet is not properly leashed you are in violation of the below covenant and subject to a \$20/ incident fine.
 - o Section 4.10 Animals
- Trash and Recycle Bins need to be kept in a neat order and pushed against houses/ fence lines when it is not a scheduled pick-up day.

Dear Resident,

At the July 18, 2022, Board meeting the Board has approved to change Trash Service providers, based on the concerns of the residents and the service that was being provided. In the process to change trash service providers there will be a meeting on August 15, 2022, to increase the quarterly dues to cover the new expense.

The Fee increase will begin effective as of September 1, 2022, that will be reflected on your 4th quarter dues for October through December. Your new rate (for trash and recycle) will go from \$45/ quarter (\$15/ month) to \$50.55/ quarter (\$16.85/ month).

Your new service with HBS Trash Service will include weekly trash AND weekly recycle pick-ups. This is one bin for Trash and one bin for Recycle (yellow lid). Please be aware of the upcoming schedule to leave the old "Springs Waste" or "Waste Connection" bins out for pick-up from the previous provider and when to expect your new bins to be delivered.

Please note do not fill past the fill line visible inside your roll off.

We will not be able to transport it per DOT regulations.

Our drivers drop off and pick up only.

If we cannot transport, you will have to have another delivered at your expense and transfer contents with your own labor.

It is important that you supervise and don't broadcast your event, as other neighborhoods will utilize your community resource with their trash.

On your collection day, please place your carts at the curb by 7:00 am with the handles facing the house to ensure pick up. Please also be sure to leave at least 2 ft of clearance between each cart and surrounding items such as mailboxes, extra bags etc. (you are allowed 3 extra Trash bags per weekly trash pick-up). Please make sure there is at least 4 ft of clearance between your totes and nearby vehicles. If you frequently have more than 3 extra bags of trash, you may rent an additional cart for \$5/month.

LARGE PICKUPS

Branches and brush must be no longer than 4 ft and tied securely in 24-in diameter bundles. Yard waste such as leaves, and grass clippings must be bagged and can be placed in trash tote. If you have more than 3 extra bags or large items such as furniture, please call at least 1 business day prior to your collection day to schedule pick up.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED

Items prohibited are dirt, sod, rocks, hazardous waste of any kind, liquids of any kind including paint (unless opened and dried out), flammable materials such as oil, or gas, concrete, hot ashes, remodeling or demolition materials, whole tires, and electronics.





RECYCLING

For information on acceptable recycling items, please see our recycling guidelines included with this letter.

HOLIDAYS & WEATHER

If a holiday falls on or prior to your collection day, service will be delayed by 1 day, i.e., the week of Memorial Day 2022, you will receive pick up on _______. Our observed holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day(Some Holidays are on weekend and it does not change your day, please see your Service Calendar to verify trash and recycle day). If we are unable to provide service due to inclement weather, collection will take place the next day following the scheduled collection day, or as soon as weather conditions allow. Please ensure your management company has your email and cellphone number for alerts regarding service.

Please note that HBS Trash Services will be doing everything we can to provide you with excellent service.
