Budget Hearing Recap

At the November 20th Board Meeting, a Public Hearing was held on the 2024 Proposed Budget. The anticipated income was not sufficient to fund the anticipated expenses as proposed for 2024. The Board reviewed the funded expenses in detail and reprioritized repair projects to reduce expenses. After discussion and adjustment, the 2024 Budget was approved.

The Rec Center Fee for 2024 has been established at \$38 per month (\$114 per quarter).

The Trash Service Fee will not change, continuing at \$16.85 per month (\$50.55 per quarter).

Billing will be \$164.55 per household, per quarter, beginning in January 2024.

2024 – What Lies Ahead?

The Board has worked hard throughout the year to evaluate the maintenance needs of the community, ranking each item by priority. The priority levels NEEDS, WANTS, and WISHES were established to aid the Board in prioritizing expenses. While funds will remain tight throughout 2024, the Board has created a plan that will allow them to address most of the NEEDS in 2024. Certain items that have been identified as NEEDS, will be accomplished by phasing in repairs over the next few years.

Specifically, dead tree replacements and mulch bed replenishment will be addressed in phases over the next 3-years.

Certain items categorized as WANTS; such as overseeding of the turf areas, weed removal in the native grasses, and installation of shade structures or benches could not be facilitated with the funding available. Trail tilling, widening, and gravel replacement has also been placed on hold for now, but will be revisited in the years to come.

City of Fountain Trail Reconstruction

At long last, the City of Fountain has received approval to move forward with reconstruction of the trail leading from Ventana to Missouri Ave. This project will include replacement of the bridge, which washed out during the June 22nd floods, as well as building the boardwalk over the wetlands.

During construction, City contractors will be utilizing portions of the Ventana parking lot off of Hidden Prairie Parkway and Cadenza Terrace for staging and storage of their equipment. We ask residents to take care not to interfere with the equipment storage and to exercise caution when utilizing the trails in the area.
