MINUTES

- 1. Call to Order: President Bahr called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M.
- 2. Declaration of Quorum/Director Qualifications/ Disclosure Matters: Ms. Hardekopf confirmed a quorum. All disclosures were properly filed with the Department of Local Affairs, State of Colorado by Mr. Susemihl.

- 3. Approval of Agenda: Ms. Hardekopf noted corrections to the date and General Fund on Agenda item 4.b. Director Vorwaller moved to approve the Agenda as corrected; seconded by Director Jarrett. Motion passed unanimously. Director Peele joined the meeting.
- 4. Regular Business Items:
 - a. Approval of Board Meeting Minutes from the March 10, 2021 Meeting
 - b. Approval of Payables for the Period ending April 14, 2021
 - General Fund \$ 22,820.05
 Bond Fund \$ TOTAL \$ 22,820.05

c. Acceptance of Unaudited Financial Statements as of March 31, 2021 and the schedule of cash position updated as of March 31, 2021

Director Peele moved to approve the Regular Business Items as presented; seconded by Director Vorwaller. Motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Market Update/Construction/Operations: Director Jarrett reported there is no active construction, and they are working on common area wrap-up as weather allows this Spring. The Ventana South project was approved by the Fountain City Council last night with unanimous vote. Grading is currently underway in the Ventana South portion.
- 6. District Management Matters
 - a. Manager's Report with COVID-19 updates: Ms. Hardekopf presented the Manager's Report. Ms. Hardekopf discussed complaints from the community about the trash service and getting proposals from other companies. Ms. Hardekopf went over the pool opening and reservation system for COVID-19 capacity restrictions. The pool is scheduled to open the first or second week of May, but still waiting for confirmation on exact opening date. The pool repairs proposals were received from Front Range Aquatech for \$1,400 and from the current Pool and Spa Manager for \$820. A proposal was also received for weights and related equipment for the gym. The Board approved the pool repairs for \$820 done by the current Pool and Spa Manager. The Board discussed the proposal for the weights and related gym equipment and agreed it is expensive considering some free weights are already provided. The Board agreed they would approve an expense of \$300 - \$400 if kettle bells can be found at that price. Ms. Hardekopf discussed a proposed pool mechanical room being constructed at the proposed splash pad and including additional space for pool equipment storage for the District. Director Jarrett directed her to contact Mr. Jim Byers to discuss.
 - b. Food Trucks April Schedule: There are currently no foods trucks scheduled, and the license expires in May. The annual license that allows food trucks is \$110. The Board unanimously approved renewing the annual license for food trucks.
 - c. Billing: Ms. Hardekopf reported on CCR violations to date.
 - April 6, 2021 bills were sent for 2nd QRT.
 - Community is built out.
 - 23 liens filed to date (4 have been removed from original 15).
 - Reminder Letters will be sent on 5/3/2021.
 - Collection Letters will be sent on 6/2/2021.
- 7. Legal Matters: Mr. Susemihl reported the financial plan is done for the bond issue, and once the bond documents are finalized the District can post notice to issue debt. Mr. Susemihl confirmed he will file the conflicts of interest statements with the Secretary of State for the board members that are connected to the development.

8. Financial Matters:

a. Bond issuance update: Mr. Kevin Walker reported they have had several meetings with the City on the Service Plan Amendment and will be making a final submittal by tomorrow. The City Council Hearing is tentatively scheduled for the first week of May, and the bond closing is anticipated at the end of June. President Bahr noted the bond rate is substantially lower than the interest cost on

the current debt, so that is part of the reason for bond issuance is to refinance at the lower interest rates and the better amortization schedule.

9. Public Comment: Ms. Hardekopf opened the meeting for public comment. Mr. Farrar reported the Boy Scouts are considering painting the fire hydrants as one of their community engagements projects. Ms. Hardekopf noted she heard from City of Fountain Water and they do not allow the painting of hydrants. Mr. Farrar confirmed he will coordinate with both the Fire Department and City of Fountain Water before moving forward.

Mrs. Miller asked what the pool capacity is. Ms. Hardekopf confirmed the pool capacity is maximum 50 people.

Mr. Laurencell requested a streetlight for the mailbox area update. Ms. Hardekopf explained that City of Fountain does not recommend an additional streetlight and would not provide a quote. Mr. Laurencell explained the mailbox area is pitch black after dark and the streetlight is pointing in the other direction, so it does not illuminate the mailboxes. He will provide a photo. Ms. Hardekopf said they did note the parking lot area not having a light, so she will contact a light contractor.

- 10. Other Business: Next Regular Meeting Date 10:00 AM on May 12, 2021. The Board confirmed the next meeting date.
- 11. Adjournment: Director Peele moved to adjourn; seconded by Director Vorwaller. Motion passed unanimously at 10:30 a.m.





Income and Expense by Month January through April 2021






Income and Expense by Month January through April 2021



Commercial Grade Shade/ Covering for Pool/ Park: (see attached report)

For the all-metal shelter options, the range of project cost to include the shelter, freight and installation would run between \$30,000 to \$40,000 depending on style. The 20' x 24' gable shelter is the lower end of the pricing and the 20' square hip shelter would be on the higher end.

For shades, you're looking at a project total in the range between \$13,000 - \$16,000 for a 20' square shade including freight and installation. The 20' (4) post hip shade and single post 20' square umbrella are on the lower side of that estimate and the 20' square cantilever umbrella is on the higher side.

General pricing above does not include any permitting (if required), and assumes normal digging conditions for installing the large footings required for shades. No concrete cutting, special digging conditions, nor concrete flatwork is included in that estimated pricing.

If you are looking at a maximum budget of around \$10k, you want to consider shades in a 10' or 12' square size. Let me know if you ave any other questions. Thanks!

SRP limits its warranty to the supply of materials that will assemble according to sealed engineered drawings and installation instructions, and can be assembled with normal expertise and with tools required and found in the construction trades. It is expressly understood that SRP's liability be limited to repair or replacement of nonconforming material at time of delivery.

SRP does not warrant product for defects caused by erection, harsh site conditions, lack of maintenance, and/or other conditions beyond SRP's control. SRP will not be held responsible for any materials that were not properly stored prior to installation. SRP reserves the right to void the limited warranty if it not installed per the installation instructions and/or unauthorized modifications.

SRP shall not be held liable for field alterations. SRP shall only be liable for meeting the building code indicated on the sealed engineered drawings.

Any replacement part under warranty is warranted for the remaining original warranty period or six (6) months, whichever is longer.

This Limited Warranty supersedes all other warranties expressed or implied. The warranty on items not manufactured by SRP (i.e. metal roofing, shingles, wood shelters), will be as passed through SRP's supplier as per their warranty; contact Customer Service for this Supplier Warranty.

This Limited Warranty is conditional upon payment in full to SRP within terms. Liability under this Warranty is limited in that it shall not exceed the original sales price of the components as supplied by SRP.

Powder Coat Warranty

This limited warranty is for the factory applied Superdurable powder coating. This 10-year pro-rated limited warranty is intended to define the obligations and limitations of the purchaser as well as the obligations and limitations of the supplier. This limited warranty is only valid if SRP has been paid in full for the cost of the shelter.

Damage occurring from shipping, erection, vandalism, accidents, or field modifications will require field touch-up immediately and periodically thereafter, which is not covered in this limited warranty.

Exposed nuts and bolts will either be supplied with a light plating or powder coating. It is the responsibility of the contractor to paint and/or touch up the nuts and bolts after erection and these must be maintained by the customer.

The 10-year limited warranty will exclude buildings erected at sites where salt air, corrosive environment, high humidity or sprinkler systems come in contact with the shelter.

Failure to maintain finish system with annual touch-up and documented maintenance procedures will void the limited warranty.

Not covered by this limited warranty are acute angles, end plates, and other accessories that are prone to minor defects on occasions and will require touch-up by owner.

Failure of the coating will be defined when at least 8% of the total coated surface has significant loss of performance or appearance characteristics when compared to the original finish. Rust stains from roof trim, screws, and screw holes do not constitute a failure.

If a claim is made for paint failure a complete document must be provided by the owner. If a site visit is required by SRP the travel expenses will be covered by the customer prior to travel taking place. However, should the failure be determined to be under the limited warranty the customer will be reimbursed for these expenses. In the case of a failed paint system, SRP will repaint the structure with its best in-house system providing that the owner dismantles the structure and returns it to SRP. SRP will refinish the structure and ship it back to job site at their expense. The refinishing will not extend the original warranty of the paint system. The owner is responsible for erecting the building at their expense. As an alternative, SRP will pay customer up to the cost of the original paint system on a pro-rated basis for time left of the 10 year limited warranty.
